HEREBY DECLARES, UNDER HIS/HER OWN RESPONSIBILITY

- **to refrain from entering the theatre**

- if you have a fever of more than 37.5°C / persistent cough / difficulty breathing / colds / sore throat / headache / loss of sense of smell or taste / diarrhea

- if you have had **close contact** with a person with Covid-19 in the last 14 days

- to agree **to have your body temperature** taken before entering the hall (if the temperature is higher than 37.5°, access will not be allowed)

- to adopt and maintain respiratory protection by correctly wearing a **“surgical” or higher category mask throughout your stay in the courtyard, including during the performance (the use of ‘community masks’ is forbidden)**

- to **respect safety distances** (minimum 1 metre; normal 1.5 metres)

- to **avoid gathering** in any part of the theatre (a gathering is defined as any group of more than two people where it is not possible to maintain a safe distance)

- to observe the correct rules of hygiene by washing your hands thoroughly and/or disinfecting them with the **sanitising gels** provided to the public by the Teatro Regio

- to undertake to **inform** the Teatro Regio of any illness or symptoms that may be attributable to a Covid-19 infection **within 48 hours** of the performance attended, by calling **+39 011.8815.241** or by writing to the following e-mail address: **info@teatroregio.torino.it**.

If the ticket is used by a different person, the holder of this e-ticket commits the actual user to **report the change** to the theatre staff at the Teatro Regio and to fill in the appropriate form with his/her personal details.
